Subject : Updates on the Movement Control Order 3.0 “Total Lockdown” in Malaysia

To : The President

Ingress Industrial (Thailand) Public Company Limited (“INGRS”) would like to inform that on 28 May 2021, the Government of Malaysia has announced the implementation of a nationwide Total Lockdown during the Movement Control Order 3.0 (“MCO”) to curb the spreading of Covid-19 virus which has reached 565,533 cases in Malaysia. The lockdown will see a full closure of social and economic sectors nationwide with the First Phase will begin from 1 June 2021 to 14 June 2021. Under the First Phase, all sectors are not allowed to operate except for essential economic and service sectors.

Based on the announcement, the Second Phase of the lockdown will be implemented after the First Phase for a period of four weeks. During the Second Phase, the operation of certain economic sectors which will not involve mass gathering will be allowed. After the completion of lockdown Second Phase, the Third Phase will be implemented where almost all economic sectors will be allowed to operate.

The implementation of the Second and Third Phases will depend on the risk assessment by the Ministry of Health and will be based on daily updates on new Covid-19 cases and the capacity of the public hospitals nationwide to offer treatment to Covid-19 patients.

Under the First Phase, some subsidiaries of INGRS in Malaysia will be temporarily closed for 14 days. The affected subsidiaries are, Ingress Industrial (Malaysia) Sdn. Bhd., Ingress Technologies Sdn. Bhd., Ingress AOI Technologies Sdn. Bhd. and Ingress Precision Sdn. Bhd.

Other subsidiaries of INGRS in Thailand, Indonesia and India are still in operation.
